 1. Male 49.7%
 2. Female 50.3%

2. If the general election for Congress were held today would you vote for the Republican candidate or the Democratic candidate? If Republican press 1, if Democratic press 2.
 1. Republican 59.7%
 2. Democratic 40.3%

3. Do you approve or disapprove of Governor John Lynch's job performance? If you approve press 1. If you disapprove, press 2. If you're not sure, press 3.
 1. Approve 44.2%
 2. Disapprove 38.4%
 3. Unsure 17.4%

4. Thank you. Some in the state legislature are considering expanding the state death penalty to include pre-mediated murder and attempted murder of children. Would you be for or against such a change? If you are for expanding the state death penalty to include pre-mediated murder and attempted murder of a child press 1. If you are against such a change press 2. If you are not sure press 3.
 1. Approve 61.0%
 2. Disapprove 28.4%
 3. Unsure 10.6%

5. Do you believe the \$850 billion stimulus package passed by congress earlier this year has been successful in creating jobs in NH? If you believe it has been successful press 1. If you do not believe it has been successful press 2. If you are not sure press 3.
 1. Successful 20.3%
 2. Unsuccessful 69.0%
 3. Unsure 10.6%

6. Thank you. And for our final question. Regardless of how you plan to vote, are you registered to vote as a Republican, a Democrat or something else? If Republican press 1, if Democrat press 2, if something else press 3.
 1. Republican 30%
 2. Democratic 31%
 3. Something else 39%
